Enforcement Action on REACH by UK Competent Authority

HSE, the UK's Competent Authority for REACH, has revealed on its website that in March and April it issued a series of REACH Improvement Notices in relation to alleged failures to pre-register or register the manufacture or import of substances. In what seems to be a coordinated campaign directed mainly at the lime products industry, notices were issued to named businesses and individuals across the UK, giving a limited time to comply or face court proceedings.
